

## Tonsorial Arts Barber College Emergency Relief Fund Report

### Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

30 Day Funding Report – Distribution as December 3, 2020

Under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), Tonsorial Arts Barber College – OPEID #04286500 received education stabilization funds designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

Pursuant to guidance issued by the Department of Education through an Electronic Announcement published on May 6, 2020, we are providing the following information about the funds we have received, and how, and to whom, we have distributed them.

Tonsorial Arts Barber College has signed and returned to the Department the Recipient's Funding Certification and Agreement (for) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students required to receive funds allocated under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. The institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 100 percent of these funds received to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.

6. The methods we used to determine which students receive emergency financial aid grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act are included below under "Student Emergency Funding Allocation".

All student at Tonsorial Arts Barber College, who are in an active enrollment status, were enrolled during our Spring term, and who have been determined eligible for Title IV funds, were given an "Emergency Financial Aid Grant (CARES ACT) Student Request Form. All of our Students have completed a FAFSA.

This process of identifying eligible students that are in a school status of active will be given a request form so they can be funded. The form provides information about the emergency financial grant, including eligibility requirements. Students are requested to check applicable areas in which they need financial support for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the Coronavirus (including education expenses, course materials, technology, food, housing, healthcare and childcare). We have also requested any updated contact information to be used to mail payments. The form requires the student's signature and attestation that the information provided is correct,

and that they understand the purpose for the emergency financial aid grant funds. Once the completed form has been received and reviewed, the eligible students are awarded the CARE funds. Students who have withdrawn or graduated from school will not receive payment(s) from the emergency financial aid grant. All funds have been fully disbursed.
